

Mosquito Rules 2010

General Information:

- Game starts @ 6:00 pm; no new inning after 8:00 pm
- Home team supplies base umpire
- Home team to phone radio station 636-6100 and to e-mail to Wendy Godfrey at wmgodfrey@sasktel.net
- Try to make up all games that were cancelled.

General Rules:

- all batters must wear batting helmet with earflaps and chin strap
- players should wear long pants or baseball pants
- only molded cleats or running shoes are permitted
- all persons receiving warm up throws in a crouched position from any pitcher must wear a protective mask.
- mosquito bats must not be more than 32 inches in length and 2 ¼ inches in diameter
- balk rule is waived
- NO Curveballs

ESTEVAN MINOR BASEBALL Operating Rules and Guidelines

The following rules apply to the **Mosquito Division**:

- 1 Games shall be 6 innings long.
- 2 During league play, no more than six (6) runs may be scored by a team in one inning (in the event of an 'over the fence' home run, all runs will count).
- 3 Any team that is 10 runs up after 4 innings shall win that game; however the game may be continued for practice purposes with the consent of both coaches.
- 4 During league games, all players listed on the team roster shall bat.
- 5 Unlimited defensive substitution allowed as per the following:
 - 5.1 Every player must play at least 2 defensive innings in the first 4 innings of a game.
 - 5.2 A pitcher removed from the mound may play in another position, but shall not be permitted to return to pitch in the same game.
 - 5.3 All defensive substitutions shall retain their batting positions.
- 6 There is no leading off. A baserunner must stay in contact with the base until the pitched ball crosses the plate. Penalties as per Baseball Canada – Official Rules of Baseball.

7 Pitching Rule: even if 1 pitch is thrown it is considered 1 inning pitched

- 2 innings 1 game
- 4 innings 1 day

- 8 innings 1 week
